- Christkindlmarket and parade will be held on Saturday, December 3, 10-3pm.
- The Annual Town Christmas Tree Lighting will be held Wednesday, December 7 at 7:00pm at Creamery Park. Please join us!
- Zoning certificate fees for fences and accessory buildings under 150 square feet have increased from \$25 to \$40. The fee for all other residential improvements—decks, additions, interior alterations, accessory buildings over 150 square feet, solar panels, swimming pools, and home occupations -- remain at \$40.
- All Town Parks have set hours. From March 15-November 14, they will be open 7am-9pm. From November 15-March 14, they will be open from 7am-5pm.

- Yard waste pickup, for in-town residents, will continue on Thursdays through December 8. 2022. Please place curbside Wednesday evening.
- Please remember, as leaves fall, make sure to clean them out of the street in front of your homes. Leaves that are left on the street get washed down into storm drains, and can clog up drain systems. This can cause unwanted flooding.
- Now that Winter is upon us, please remember, Town code states that cars must be moved off the street when there is an accumulation of 4" or more of snow/ice. This allows the plows to safely clear the streets. Also, sidewalks must be cleared within 24 hours after the snow stops.
