#### News

- The Annual Town Christmas Tree Lighting will be held at Creamery Park on Wednesday, December 6, at 7:00pm. Please join us!
- The Christkindlmarket and Parade will be held on Saturday, December 2, from 10am-3pm
- Channel 99 is now available to residents with local cable. This will be updated regularly with Town happenings and information.
- The online Town Code is now accessible through the homepage on the Town website.
- Sign-up for The Walkersville Wire at www.walkersvillemd.gov, to receive important, up to the minute updates from The Town.
- Now that Winter is upon us, please remember that Town code states that cars must be moved off the street when there is an accumulation of 4" or more of snow/ice. This allows the plows to safely clear the streets. Sidewalks must also be cleared within 24 hours after snow stops.
- Walkersville has a permanent, year-round water ban that prohibits lawn watering between the hours of 9am and 6pm.
- Weather permitting, street sweeping will be done November 20 and 21, with a rain date of the 22nd.
- Yard waste pickup, for in-town residents, will continue on Thursdays through December 14, 2023. Please place curbside Wednesday evening.
- Bulk trash pickup for in-town residents will be November 4, 2023.
- Park hours will be 7am to 5pm, beginning November 15,
- As leaves begin to fall, please make sure to clean them out of the street in front of your home. Leaves that are left in the gutters will get washed into storm drains, causing clogging of drain systems and flooding.

#### Zoning

You need a Town zoning certificate for the following home improvements:

- Building addition
- Interior alterations / renovations
- Fences
- Swimming pools & hot tubs
- Accessory buildings and sheds
- Propane tanks
- Home-base businesses
- -You do NOT need a zoning certificate for roof replacements or repairs, siding replacement or repairs, patios, or play equipment.
- -Submit a Zoning Certificate (found on the Town website), with a plot plan, and \$40 to the town for approval.
- -An approved zoning certificate must be submitted with your building permit application to Frederick County.

\*If you live in a neighborhood with an HOA, you should check uour covenants as well.


#### 2023 Events:

#### WE NOW HAVE ONLINE BILL PAY FOR WATER BILLS!\*

In order to set up an account, residents must first provide a phone number to the Town office. Then visit www.walkersvillemd.gov to register.

\*There is a 2.25% convenience fee to utilize this service.

# **WARNING: DOXO Utility Bill Payment**

DOXO is a third-party bill pay service that is not affiliated in any way with the Town. DOXO will appear as an option for you to pay your water bill if you perform a Google search, because they pay Google to ensure they are a top result. **Please only use the link available on the Town website to make online payments.** If you have any questions or concerns, kindly contact the Town Hall Office Monday through Friday between 8:30AM and 4:30PM.

Water meters are read on April 1 and October 1 of every year. Bills are *mailed* May 1 and November 1, and *due* June 1 and December 1, respectively.\*\* Payment is expected within 30 days of the billing date. Interest accrues at the rate of 1% per month on the outstanding balance. Failure to pay within a timely manner, could result in water disconnection. There is a \$100 reconnection fee during business hours.

\*\* A \$50 assessment fee will be added to water bills through November 2023, to offset the cost of the new water treatment plant.

### WATER BILL ASSISTANCE

If you have difficulty paying your bill, please call the Town Office immediately upon receiving your bill, to set up a payment plan. We will work out a payment schedule with you. You are subject to disconnection if your bill is not paid by the due date (i.e. bill dated 5/1 is due 6/1, bill dated 11/1 is due 12/1).

# **Seniors**

- Seniors meet once a week, from 11-2, in the second floor meeting room of the Town Hall. For more information, and lunch reservations, call 301.845.7174.
- The Town of Walkersville offers a Senior Tax Credit for homeowners age 65 and over. The amount of the Walkersville tax credit is 50% of the net Town tax. This is a supplement to the State's Homeowner Tax Credit and County's Senior Tax Credit, and all qualifications and limitations of these credits apply. The credit was effective with the July 1, 2021 real estate tax bill. When residents complete a State Homeowner Tax Credit application, it will apply to the State Homeowner Tax Credit, County Senior Tax Credit, and Walkersville Senior Tax Credit. If the homeowner qualifies for the County's Senior Tax Credit and resides within the Town's municipal limits, they will qualify for the Town's tax credit.
